**Subject: Make Every ‘Step’ Count on Tax Returns for 2014!**

Qualified AARP Tax preparation volunteers will provide assistance at no cost, to qualified Grand Traverse County residents, beginning February 2, 2015. Low to middle-income Grand Traverse County residents, age 60 and over, are eligible to receive free tax preparation services for ‘simple’ federal and state of Michigan 2014 income tax returns, until April 15, 2015. Taxpayers with complex tax returns are advised to seek paid tax assistance. The steps to get started are as easy as 1, 2, 3 . . . First, complete an AARP intake form (available at the Senior Center (801 E. Front Street), or by calling 231-922-4911 – one will be mailed); Next, return intake form to Senior Center (in person, or by mail); Finally, upon review by tax-help volunteer, applicant will be contacted, if eligible, to set up an appointment in order to assist applicant in filing a correctly completed tax return.
