Subject to favorable weather and contractor scheduling, the following is an update on GTCRC 2014 projects for the remainder of the upcoming week.

Supply Road - Crews will continue tree work and ditching operations during the week.

Holiday Road/Five Mile Intersection – Motorists should anticipate delays as lane closures will occur as crews extend an existing culvert pipe on Tuesday, September 2, 2014.

US-31 near the State Park – Motorists will experience lane shifts as crews cut trees on the south side of the road. Work is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 and last three days.

North Long Lake Road, between Deerpath Road and Skiver Road – Crews will be performing erosion control along the lakeshore (near the “Stone Wall”) beginning on Wednesday, September 3, 2014. Motorists will see lane closures directed by flaggers. Work may last up to four days.

Hobbs Highway - The remaining fog seal work will be performed this week. Motorists should expect delays and follow the flagger’s instructions to avoid fog material on their vehicle.

Elk Lake Road - Shoulders will be improved on Elk Lake Road between M-72 to the Grand Traverse County line. Motorists should expect lane closures directed by flaggers for approximately one week.
