

## **HEADLINE: County Board Votes to Upgrade 911 Capability**

Traverse City -- Your Grand Traverse County Board of Commissioners met for their regular monthly meeting last night [July 29, 2015] at the Governmental Center, and took some of the following actions.

- Passed a resolution approving the 2016 Commission on Aging's Implementation Plan.
- Approved proceeding with the "request for proposal" process for an energy audit of County buildings and facilities.
- Approved a resolution to enter into a member subscriber agreement with the Michigan Public Safety Communications System for the County's 911 program.
- Approved a contract in the amount of \$3,566,919 with Motorola for new dispatch consoles, BHF simulcast paging, and 800 MHz radio subscriber units to upgrade the County's 911 system.
- Approved a joint application with the Land Information Access Association (LIAA) for a \$220,000 Michigan Coastal Zone Management Grant for Boardman Trail West, Phase III, with a water trail component. This includes a local grant match of \$200,000 for the Boardman Lake Trail, to be recommended from the Boardman Lake Trail Brownfield Plan.

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
