

AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE  
FIRE PREVENTION CODE OF GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY  
ORDINANCE NO: 14  
PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Grand Traverse County has determined that the protection of life and property is of paramount concern to the citizens of Grand Traverse County and;

WHEREAS, in order to safeguard life and property of the citizens of Grand Traverse County from the hazards of fire and explosion in new or existing buildings, structures or premises used for human habitation, work and recreation, the Board of Commissioners believes that the fire prevention code is an effective means to achieve public safety and welfare and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners resolves to adopt this Amendment to the Ordinance establishing the minimum regulations governing the safeguarding of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosions arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices; and from conditions hazardous to life and property in the use or occupancy of buildings, structures or premises; and to require certain permits and to establish permit fees to implement and sustain the Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Grand Traverse County that Section III of the Ordinance adopted on January 30, 1991 be amended as follows:

A. Amendment to the Ordinance

III. Additions, Insertions and Changes:

A. Section F-104.1 (page 4, line 2).

Insert after the word department:, "Grand Traverse County Fire Department, Urban and Rural Chiefs, and Chief, Peninsula Township Fire Department",

B. Except for the amendment to Section F-104.1, all other sections of the Ordinance, as adopted on January 30, 1991, shall continue with the same force and effect.

C. Effective Date of Amendment:

The Amendment of the Ordinance and the Code, adopted pursuant to the Ordinance, shall take effect when notice of the adoption of this Amendment to the Ordinance and the Code adopted pursuant to the Ordinance is published in a newspaper of general circulation in Grand Traverse County and after this Ordinance is signed by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and after the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners shall have engrossed this Amendment to the Ordinance.
