## Keep America Beautiful Park Recycling Grants Available

The Dr Pepper Snapple - Keep America Beautiful Park Recycling Infrastructure Grant program is designed to build or expand recycling opportunities in different park settings such as urban parks, neighborhood parks with playgrounds, athletic fields, regional and state parks, public beaches and developed public water front areas such as board walks. The grant is open to local and state government agencies that deal with recycling activities. **Applications are being accepted until June 10, 2016.**

## Got Household Hazardous Waste?

*Sign up for the HHW Collection event scheduled for Thursday June 23 from 1:00 pm - 7:00 pm*

### ***Are you a household that has hazardous waste in need of disposal?***

- **Appointments are required** and can be made online at [www.recyclesmart.info](http://www.recyclesmart.info) or by calling 231-941-5555.

### ***Are you a business, school, church or other organization that has hazardous waste in need of disposal?***

1. **Verify that you meet the "Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator" (CESQG) conditions by clicking [here](#).**
2. **ADVANCED REGISTRATION is REQUIRED, BY TELEPHONE ONLY** - CESQGs are required to register for an appointment via telephone by calling 231-941-5555. Please do **NOT** use the online appointment system.
3. **SUBMIT CESQG FORM 5 DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT** - The CESQG form is required to be submitted no less than 5 business days prior to the event. This allows the hazardous waste company to be properly prepared to accommodate the type and quantity of material

on the day of the event. CESQGs who **do not** submit forms at least 5 days in advance of the event are at risk of being turned away.

Car Seats - Remove all fabric, rubber and metal attachments	No mirror glass, window glass or TV/monitor glass.
Boxes, cardboard and paper	No light Bulbs - fluorescent, tubes & CFLs
Paper beverage/drink cartons -- milk, juice, drink boxes	No foam products - packing peanuts, molded Styrofoam, foam wrap
Glass bottles and containers -- all colors	No batteries
Metal - cans, foil, trays, EMPTY aerosol cans	No Fluids - paint, stain, automotive fluids
Plastic bottles and containers - type #1 through #7, and unmarked	No sharps or medical waste
Plastic Bags & Film - Grocery bags, Bread bags, Dry Cleaning Bags, Shrink Wrap, Visqueen
